GPS: 50.4937058N, 15.5063456E

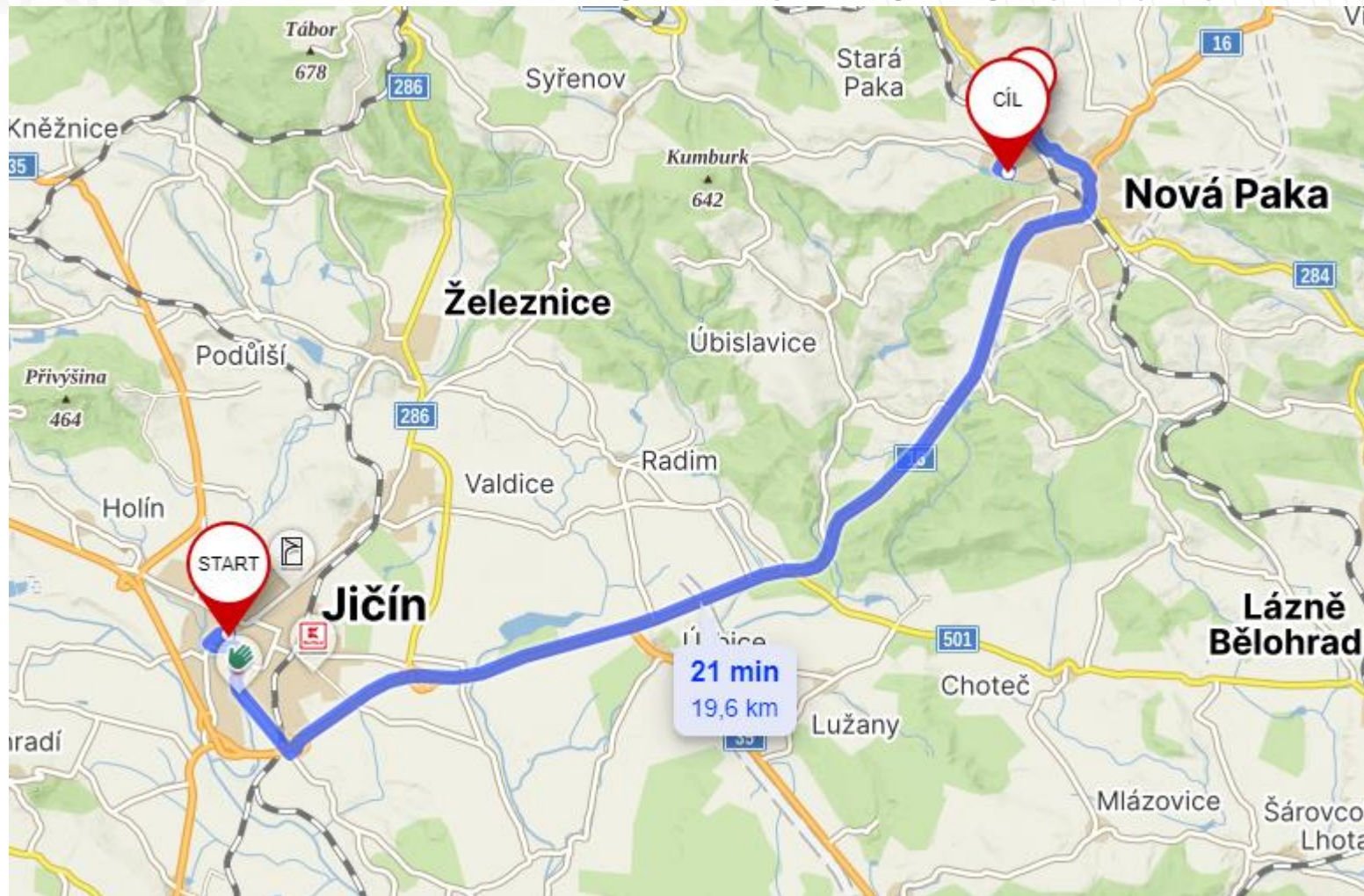
Access to the parking and to the arena – in Nová Paka, from streets Kumburská and Šlejharova, see detailed picture.

Respect embargoed areas.

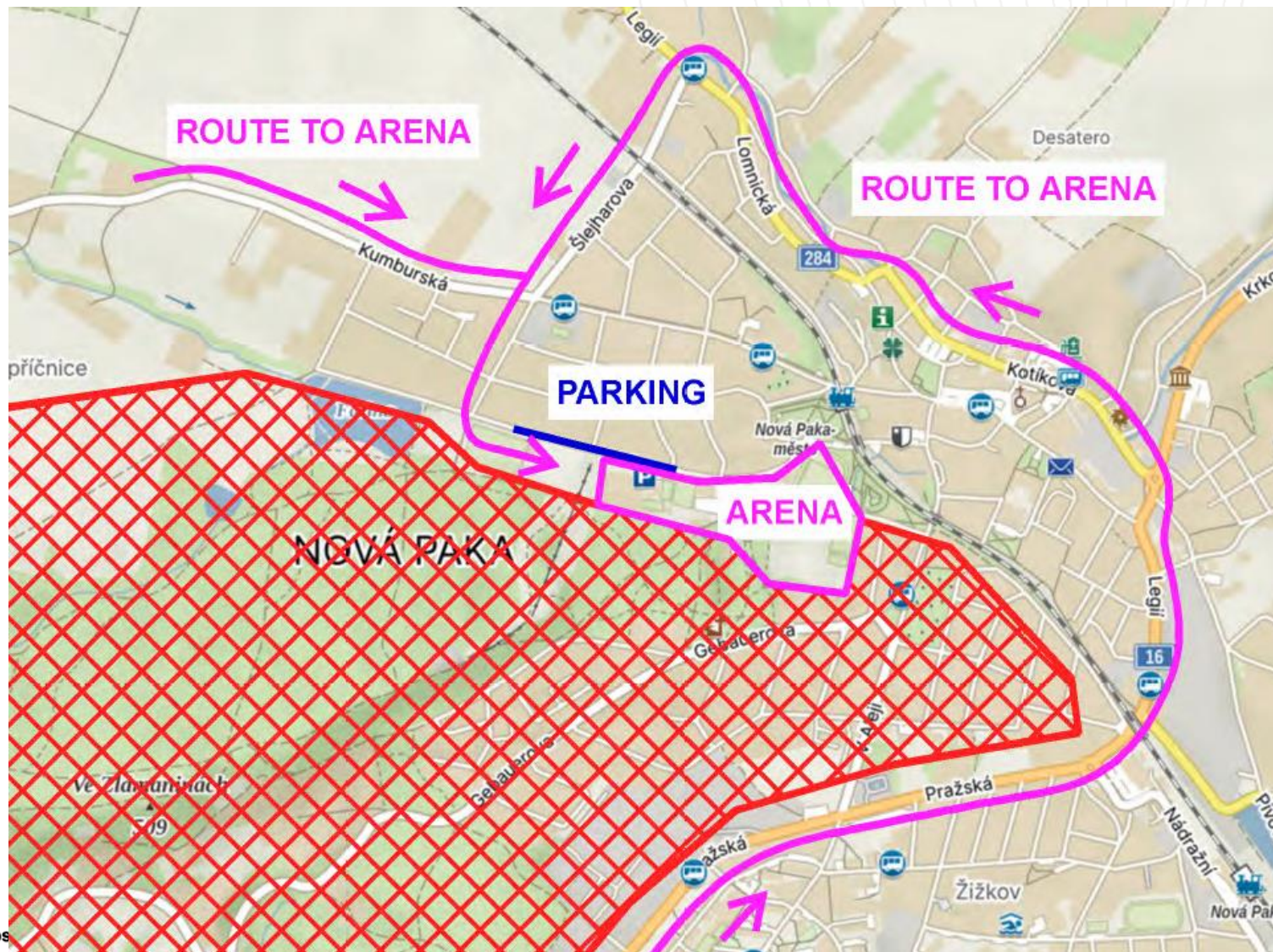
Marked with signs, please follow the instructions from marshals.
It is not allowed to park anywhere else, only dedicated official parking areas are allowed.

Distance from parking to the Arena: up to 300 m (walk)

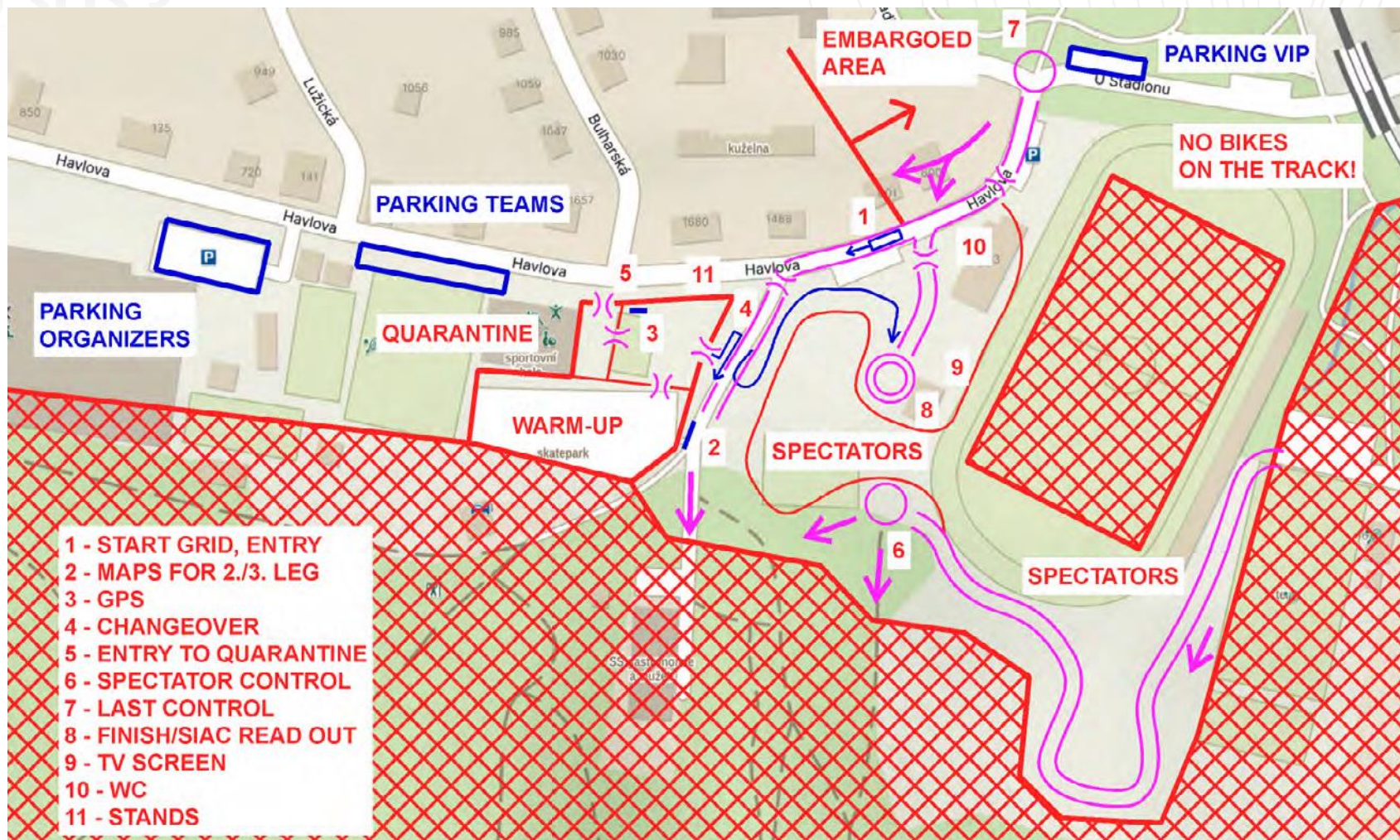
Relay day – Logistics - Recommended route from Jičín to Nová Paka

Relay day – GPS & Quarantine

1st leg: no quarantine, no GPS, warm-up – use the street around the parking

2nd and 3rd leg: start quarantine

Start quarantine open 9:00

Last entry into the quarantine zone 10:20

Warm-up area is a part of quarantine zone.

Quarantine facilities - toilets, tents, refreshment (water)

Exit from quarantine is situated in the E part.

Before leaving quarantine – CLEAR & CHECK your SIAC and all athletes will be asked to wear a GPS unit. GPS units for the 2nd and 3rd leg will be distributed in a quarantine zone. All athletes riding 2nd and 3rd leg will be riding with a GPS.

GPS pickup time for 2nd leg: 10:20, at the quarantine zone

GPS pickup time for 3rd leg: 10:40, at the quarantine zone

GPS unit must be worn in a special vest provided to each team or in a special pocket on the back, which holds the unit in a vertical position. GPS units must be returned in the finish area.

There will be no finish quarantine.

Relay day – Quarantine

We kindly ask all competitors to mount their start bibs on their bikes or to know their actual start number before entering the quarantine zone.

Team bags:

Riders' clothes and other personal belongings will be transported from a quarantine to the finish arena. Please, put your items into appropriate bag/backpack and sign it with your start number and national team acronym (CZE, FRA, SWE...).

Please, do not send large or heavy items (service tools, bike spare parts, suitcases etc.)!

No bottles with refreshment to be delivered to the course.

No material control in the course.





Relay day – Finish quarantine

All competitors arrived to the finish before 10:20 should stay in the finish quarantine next to SIAC reading area till 10:20

Time from spectator's control to the finish: approx. 8-10 min.

Relay day – Punching & backup

Punching system – SportIdent SIAC, Long range
Backup punching system – SportIdent contact
Backup for competitors – second SIAC

Recommendation from SportIdent:
Keep approx 30 cm distance between cards,
when you wear two SIACs to keep maximum
reliability, if possible.

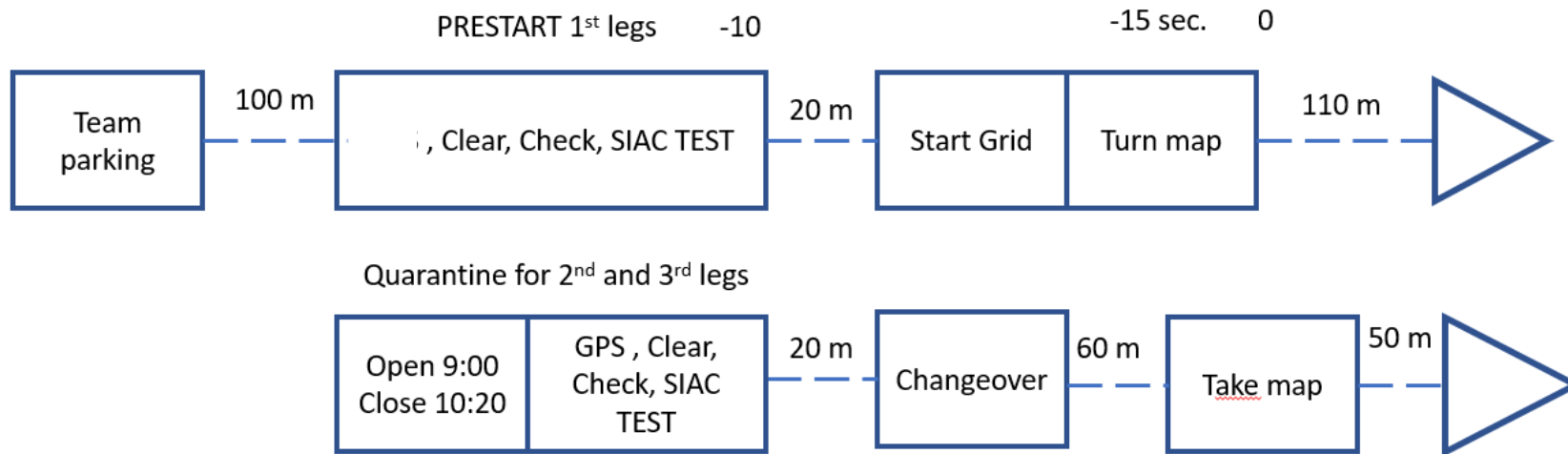

Relay day – Starting procedure

1st legs are called to the prestart 10 minutes prior to their start, according to the table:

	Prestart	Start
M20	9:50	10:00
W20	10:00	10:10
W	10:00	10:10
M	10:10	10:20





Relay day – Starting procedure

1st legs:

Mass Start starting procedure. 1st leg competitors will enter the starting grid from the prestart, 10 minutes before their mass start to put their bikes on marked starting positions. 3 minutes before start all first leg riders must stand on their starting position. Maps will be provided 3 minutes before start and placed course down on the map holder. Signal will be given 15 seconds before start to turn over the maps.

The bike must be stationary and competitors must keep at least one foot on the ground until the starting signal. A false start will result in a time penalty. The start will not be repeated.

After the start the rider follows a mandatory route (corridor) to the map start marked by a flag in the terrain, distance to map start is approx. 110 m.

Show respect for other riders.



Relay day – Starting procedure

2nd and 3rd legs:

Changeover is realized by touch in changeover area. Then the rider reaches the starting area, takes the map and follows the marked path to the map start. GPS pickup, CLEAR, CHECK and SIAC TEST for 2nd and 3rd legs will be situated at the quarantine zone.

Again, times for GPS pickup:

GPS pickup time for 2nd leg: 10:10, at the quarantine zone

GPS pickup time for 3rd leg: 10:40, at the quarantine zone

Starting and changeover procedures will be shown at 9.30.

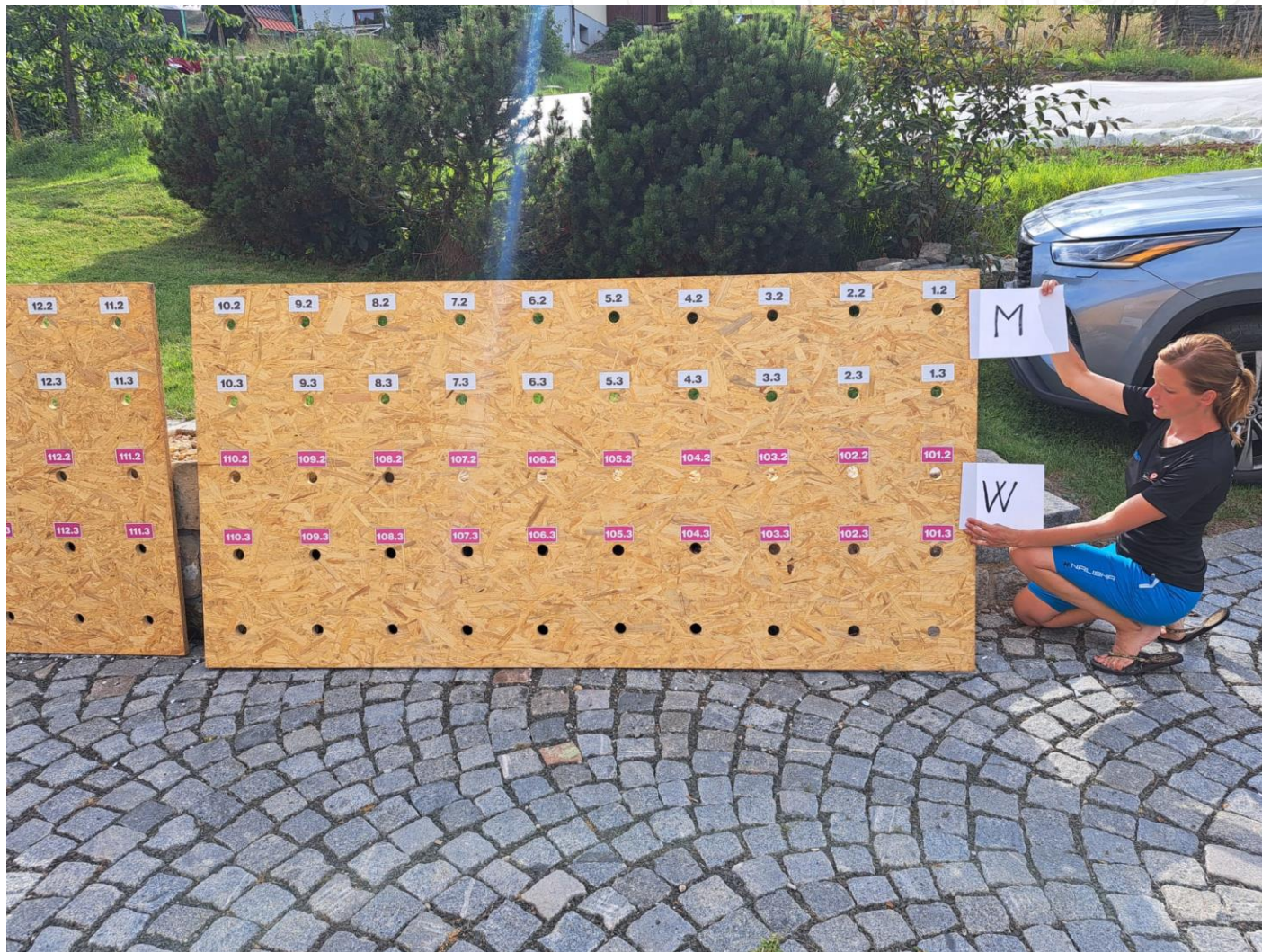

Relay day – Finish procedure

First and second legs:

First and second leg riders cross the finish line in the continuous (parallel) corridor. When entering into the transition area they hand over to the next rider by touch and then they will punch a finish control when leaving the transition area. After this the rider reads the SI Card.

Third leg:

The winner is the first rider to cross the finish line. A finish SI box will be held by a referee to punch finish in order of arrival in the finish line. Please follow marshal's directions to keep in order.

JURY member and national controller will be present on the finish line.





Relay day – Courses, maps

All courses contain compulsory route, marked by a corridor in the terrain.
In the map the compulsory route is marked by symbol 707 Marked route (purple).

Approximately in the center of the first map, there is an out-of-bound area, marked by symbol 709 Out-of-bounds area, not marked in terrain. There is a childrens camp, be careful when riding nearby.

Relay day – Courses, maps



There are a few very new obstacles, which are not in the map - pile of branches. They can be easily bypassed by side, there will be also a tape path.

Relay day – Courses, maps

There are a lot of forest areas with a dense irregular network of footpaths and a base that enables driving everywhere, good rideability, good visibility. Marked in map by black dots, symbol 825.1 Forested area, permitted to ride or 825.2 Minor forested area, permitted to ride.






Relay day – Restrictions

Off-track riding (including running and walking with the bike) is prohibited during all races, except map symbols where riding is permitted!

Also cutting is strictly prohibited.

The following symbols (ISMTBOM 2022) will be used to show where off-track riding (or movement) is permitted.

501 Paved area (tarmac or gravel)		827 Narrow ride, permitted to ride: fast riding	
824 Open land, permitted to ride		829 Narrow ride, permitted to ride: slow riding	
825 Forested area, permitted to ride		830 Narrow ride, permitted to ride: very slow riding	
826 Rough open land, permitted to ride		All other off-track areas are forbidden!	



Relay day – SAFETY

Courses outside villages are crossing some small roads or the riders will ride on these roads. Reduced car traffic is possible. There will be marshals in most critical places, but generally riders are asked to follow traffic rules. Riders DO NOT HAVE absolute priority in the traffic.

Please watch out for pedestrians, mushroom pickers and tourists.

Two very steep downhills will be marked in the terrain and also in the map with a sign with exclamation marks.



Relay day – DOPING

Please read AD information given in Bulletin #4.

Call for AD testing may happen any time.



Relay day – OTHER

Starting bibs

Starting bib will be given out to each competitor for each discipline. The starting bib has to be placed in the front of the bike, tapes to fit the numbers will be distributed with bibs.

Complaints

Complaints may only be made by accredited team officials or competitors, at the finish as soon as possible after the incident or at the latest at **14:30**. Complaints received after this limit will be considered if there are valid exceptional circumstances (described in the complaint).

Any complaints shall be made in writing to the organizer – in that case please contact staff in the finish.



Relay day – OTHER

Prize giving ceremony

Will be organized giving ceremony at the Event Centre at 17:00. There will be awarded first 6 best placed competitors in each category. In line with IOF rules podium finishers are requested to dress in team uniforms.

Catering service (food ordered by teams in advance) will be available at the finish arena.
